RE: Public Toilet Accessibility

Thank you for your letter dated 31st January 2019 advising of an opportunity to improve access for people with physical disabilities in the Inner West and protect Council from discrimination complaints.

I am pleased to confirm that the Inner West Council public amenities within parks and open spaces are accessible seven days a week, opened at sunrise, and locked within one hour of sunset. Public amenities within Council buildings and facilities are opened in accordance with the operating hours of each facility.

The amenities that are listed on the Australian Government *ToiletMap* and identified in your letter are located within Council buildings and therefore opened during the applicable business hours.

Liverpool Road, Ashfield (Ashfield Civic Centre) 8.30am to 5.00pm Monday to Friday

Elizabeth Street, Ashfield (Ashfield Aquatic Centre) Closed - currently under development.

All Inner West Council amenities are keyed to Council's internal system. The MLAK key system is not supported as all public amenities are accessible during daylight hours.

I can also confirm that Council has committed to review all public toilets as part of the Public Toilet Strategy for improved accessibility requirements and adjustments as part of the Inclusion Action Plan for People with a Disability 2017 – 2021.
