THE SCOURGE OF LOCKED ACCESSIBLE TOILETS

Thank you for your letter dated 23 January 2019 regarding the use of the Master Locksmith Access Key (MLAK) accessible toilets within the Cumberland Council Local Government Area.

Council can confirm that the locations identified in your letter with the exception of Terminal Place Merrylands, are opened during daylight hours and no MLAK keys are required to access these facilities. I would also like to advise that the Terminal Place Toilet facility is the property of Transport for NSW and not Council.

The information contained in the Australian Toilet Map website has been reviewed and it appears that the data requires updating as Council is committed to having toilets open and accessible during daylight hours and the toilets listed in your correspondence are open and accessible.
